



## HOLTVILLE HIGH SCHOOL COMMUNITY BASED SCHOLARSHIPS



Scholarships require recipients to seek education and training beyond high school. GPA and citizenship or legal residency may also be important. Some require students to major in certain academic subjects or show an interest in that area. If you haven't already begin your personal statement now! Many people will read the applications and providers meet only occasionally. So, meeting deadlines is crucial. Do not expect extensions. Prioritize your list by deadline and seek only those you qualify for. Make sure you know how the application is to be delivered. Some are mailed while others may be dropped off in the counseling office. Do not wait; a rushed application is a poor one!

**Step 1 – Gather the scholarships that you qualify for; there may be more than one. (Some have one application, but may offer different scholarships.) Begin working on essays. Remember, you do not need to begin a new essay for each scholarship. Most scholarships have similar essay prompts. It is okay to just tweak one essay to fit another scholarship. See each application for exact requirements.**

**Step 2 – Make a list of what is required for each scholarship. Prioritize by due dates. For clarification, contact whoever is offering the scholarship. Check the cover letter in the application or see your counselor.**

**Step 3 – Obtain an application from the counseling office or download one from HUSD's or community based organization's website, if available. Refer to the scholarship form often for details and critical information such as: deadlines, requirements, other items to include in your folder along the application. See your counselors if you have any questions.**

**Step 4 – Scholarship Format is Important! Do not alter from it and place all items requested in a folder: Note, the order of each items should be listed on the application.**

**Step 5 – DO NOT MISS ANY DEADLINES All applications indicate how you should deliver the scholarship. If a folder is needed, use one. (i.e. drop off in the counseling office or mail to the address indicated. If you hand deliver-remember to DRESS appropriately.)**

Unofficial transcripts are requested from Mrs. Soto. Official transcripts must come from Mrs. Diez. Request them days before you need them and ask for several at one time or make extra copies so you won't have to request more when you need them later.

The counseling department can help. If needed, ask for guidance to complete your activity chart, personal resume, format your essay or help with other requirements. Applications that do not meet GPA requirements or do not have all requested documents will be disqualified and will not be considered.
