Article IV – Criteria for Hall of Fame Selection

Section 1. Hall of Fame categories establish in the inaugural year: Alumni/Students, Community Members, and Educators

Proposed minimum criteria for Hall of Fame eligibility to be as follows:

- A. Alumni/Students
 - 1. Alumni – Must have demonstrated outstanding achievement after graduating from HHS such as:
 - a. Completion of education at a prestigious university
 - b. Established in a business or profession
 - c. Noteworthy accomplishment
 - 2. Students – Must have demonstrated outstanding achievement in one of the following areas:
 - a. Arts (art, music, speech)
 - b. Athletics (guidelines for selection)
 - i. Legends – those who may qualify under (1) and (2)
 - ii. Athletes of the Decade – those who may qualify under (1, 2, 3, or 4)
 - iii. Hall of Fame – those who may qualify under (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6)
 - 1. International Accomplishment: Competed in Olympic games or officially recognized US team in an individual or team sport
 - 2. National Accomplishment: One who has won, or placed in an amateur national individual or team sport competition
 - 3. California State Accomplishment: One who has won, or placed in a California State individual or team sport
 - 4. California Interscholastic Federation: In addition to above, one who was selected player of the year, or first team, to a CIF team in any sport
 - 5. League/Conference: One who was selected player of the year in any sport in the league/conference.
 - 6. Special Consideration: One who has distinguished himself/herself, in any capacity, in any sport, or sports at Holtville High School
 - a. Leadership (school offices, activities, projects)
 - b. Scholarship
- B. Community Members (at Large) – Must have demonstrated outstanding Support for the HS and its campus by one of the following:
 - 1. Volunteer leadership
 - 2. Committee work
 - 3. Contribution of time or assets
- C. Educators –
 - 1. Administrators – Must have demonstrated outstanding leadership in one of the following areas:
 - a. Improvement of campus environment and/or school facilities
 - b. Successful academic climate
 - 2. Campus Staff – Must have demonstrated outstanding contributions in servicing campus needs of students and educators.
 - 3. Coaches – Must have demonstrated outstanding success and award winning accomplishments in the area of
 - a. Athletics
 - b. Extra-curricular teams (ex. Music, speech)
 - 4. Teachers – District Wide: (Amended 9-22-16) Must have demonstrated outstanding service to students through one or more of the following areas:
 - a. Classroom excellence
 - b. Student guidance
 - c. Extra-curricular or staff leadership
